Pākaraka school is situated a short drive from Kerikeri town centre in a rural setting close to the beautiful Bay of Islands. The school is a small state school developing a Steiner unit that will run alongside mainstream classes starting term 1 2024. This is in partnership with the Bay of Islands Waldorf Education Trust who govern Oromahoe Kindergarten, located 5 minutes down the road.

The successful applicant will be collaborative, creative, flexible, interested in new ideas, and able to take initiative. Additionally, we are looking for someone who is dedicated and demonstrates inclusivity for Te Tiriti o Waitangi, while also having the willingness and ability to fully embrace Te Ao Māori. An understanding of the local curriculum, with a specific focus on Te Ao Māori, is highly desirable. Alongside experience teaching core subjects such as literacy and numeracy, knowledge and experience in teaching music, te reo Māori and handwork is advantageous. They will have a commitment to Steiner pedagogy, the ability to work with composite classes and flexibility that suits a smaller school. The Bay of Islands Waldorf Education Trust will provide the successful applicant ongoing mentoring in Steiner Waldorf education.
